Aim	Make our school a home for local wildlife.
Action(s)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Make a bug hotel/add to any existing bug hotels• Bird house, bee houses, hedgehog house and bird feeders• Plant wildflower seeds
Informing & Involving	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Share pictures of the projects with the whole school during assembly• Children to visit the bug hotels during science lessons• Involve Gardening Club with planting wildflowers• Involve Rainbow Club and EYFS with making bird feeders
Monitoring & Evaluation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tally of different creatures found in the bug hotel• Count how many bird feeders are found around school• Count wildflowers planted
