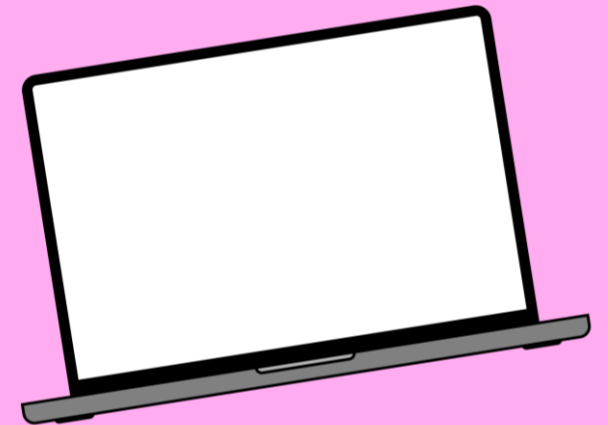
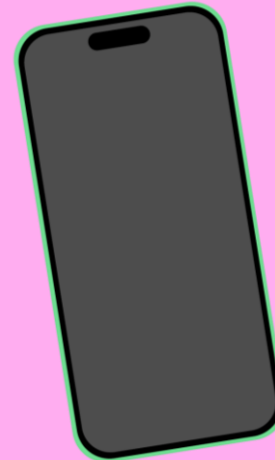
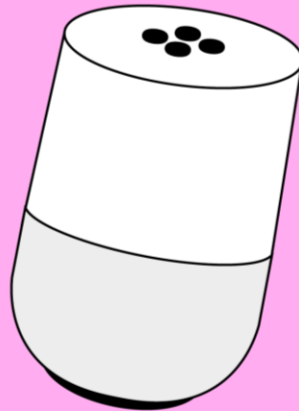
What do you think Safer

Things online look very different now than they did a few years ago...

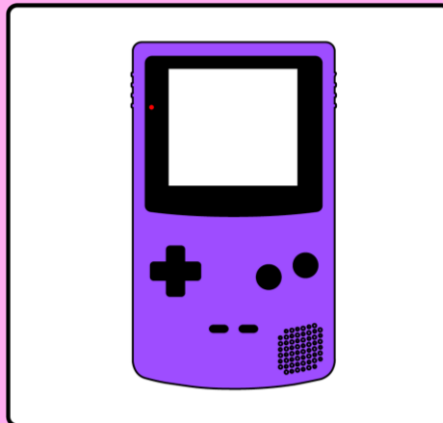
Computers used to look like this...

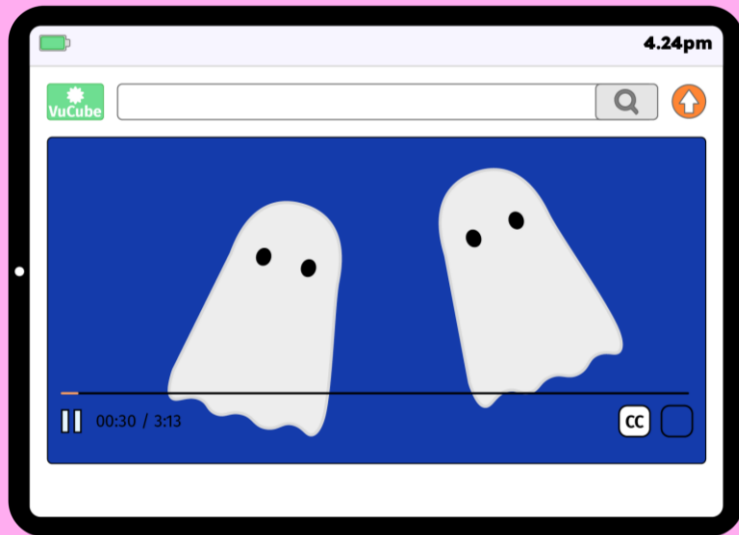


Some settings change on your game

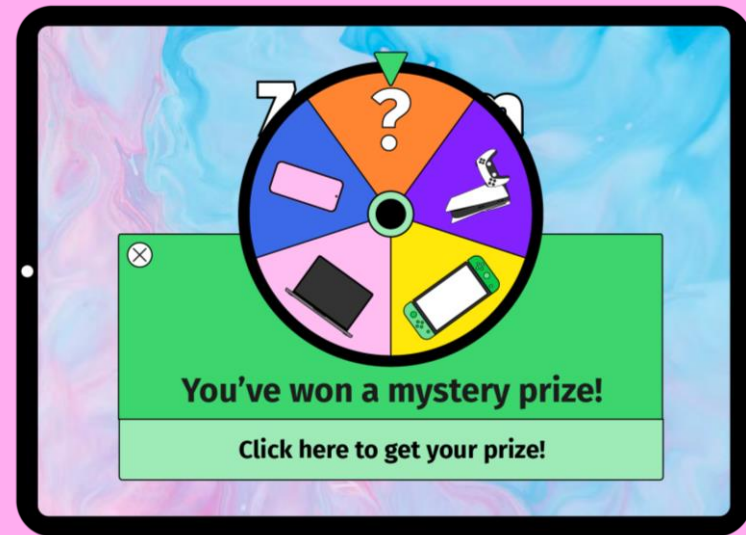
There are lots of smaller changes that happen online and on our devices every day. Can you think of any changes you have seen?

How can you stay safe even when things change online?

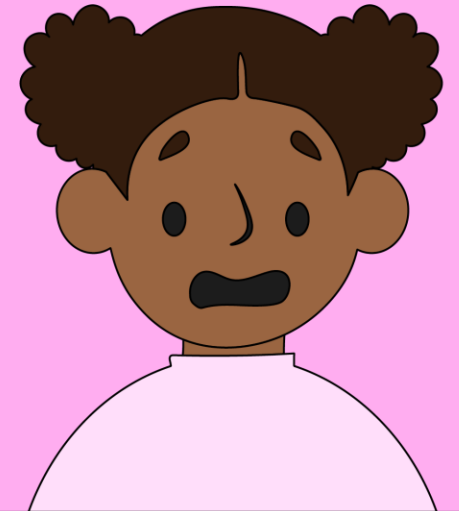
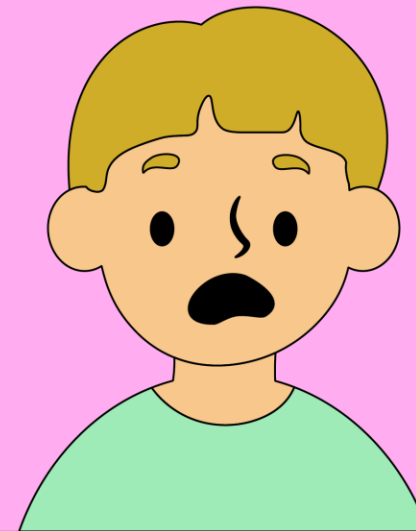
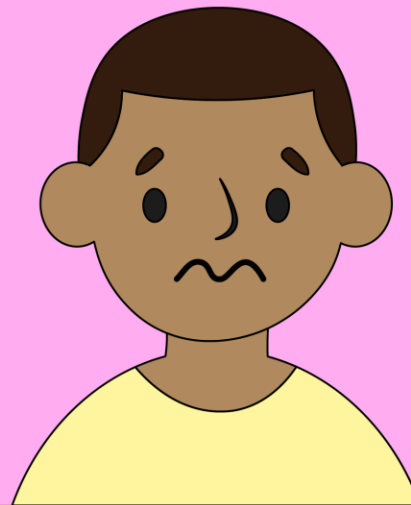
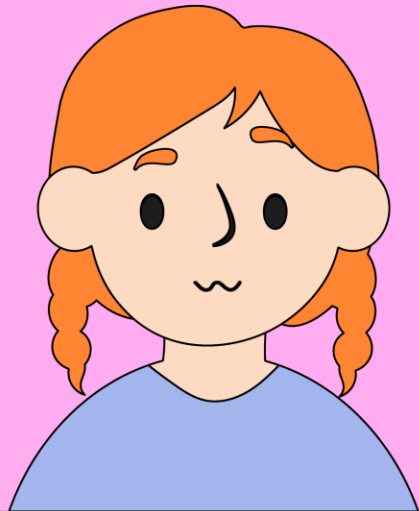
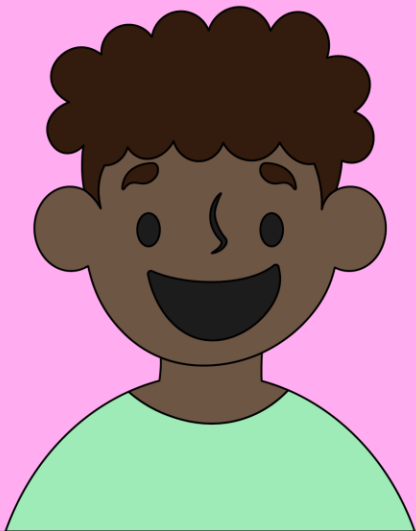
Talk to a trusted adult
