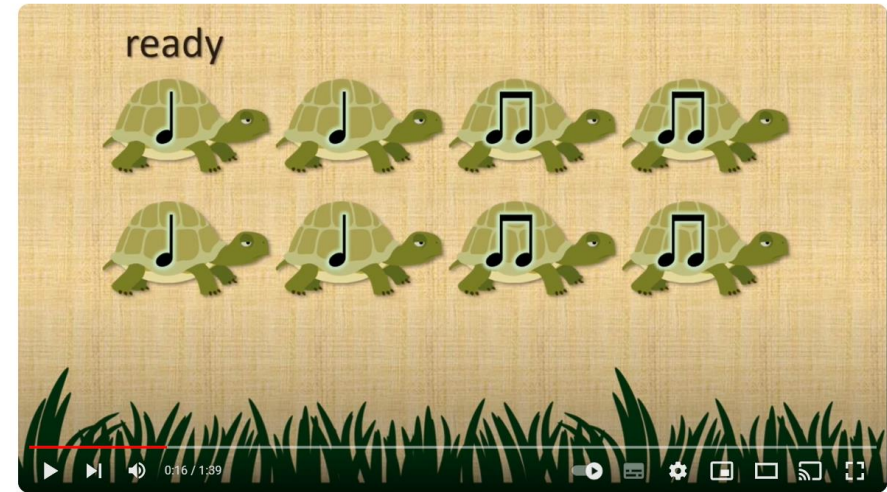

A song based on The Twits – possibility to learn

Roly – Poly Bird Rhyming strings

Children create a verse to the Roly-Poly Bird's rhyme.

Structure: Line one: explains that there's glue/sticky stuff on the tree

Line two: warns birds not to land on the tree

Line three: advises birds what to do

Line four: outlines the consequences

Can children record their rhythms for each line and put it together to create a musical story?

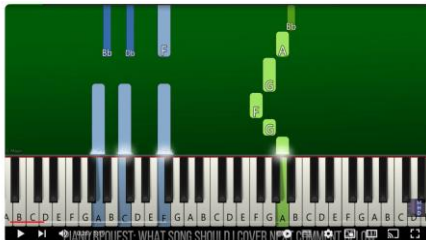


