More than 10,000 men and women from the Caribbean volunteered in the Second World war to help Britain.

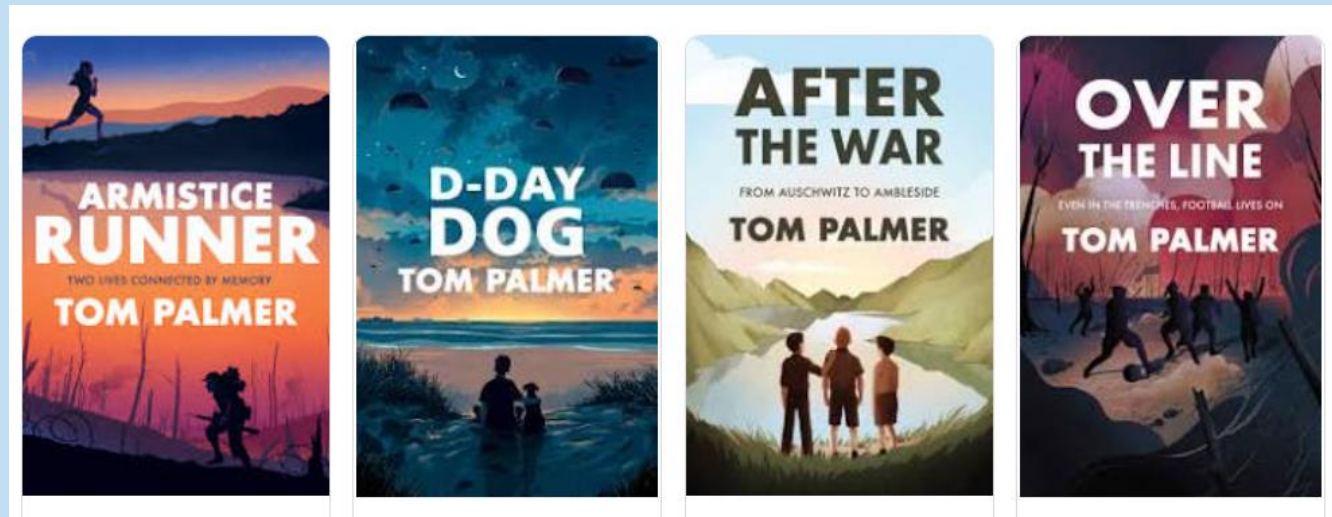

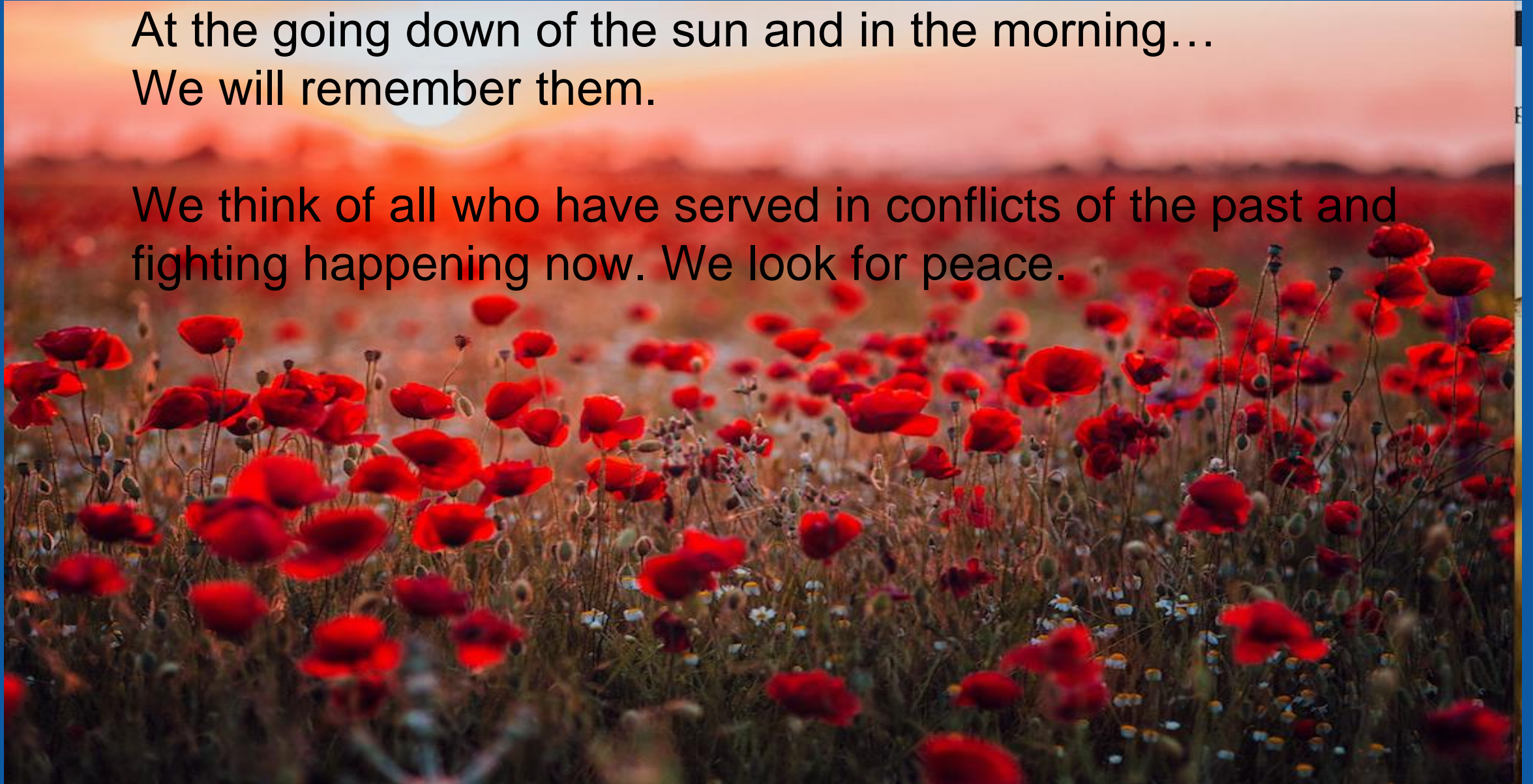
